Jim Reyelt began his undergraduate studies at Valencia College in Orlando, Florida, under the instruction of Dr. Troy Gifford. He completed his both his Bachelor of Music and Master of Music in classical guitar performance at Florida Atlantic University, studying with Dr. Ken Keaton. He is the guitar instructor at the University of South Alabama and is currently in his last semester of his Doctorate Degree in classical guitar performance at the University of Southern Mississippi under the instruction of Dr. Nicholas Ciraldo.

Since beginning his studies, Jim has won multiple classical guitar competitions and scholarships including first prize in the FCSAA convention and competition, first prize in the FAU Concerto Competition, was the recipient of both the Doris Paisley Memorial Musical Scholarship and the National Society of Arts and Letters Scholarship, and was awarded a full-time graduate teaching assistantship in the guitar department at Florida Atlantic University and The University of Southern Mississippi.

Jim has participated in master classes with world-renowned guitarists such as Andrew York, Adam Holzman, Daniel Bolshoy, Xavier Jara, Andrew Zohn, Adam Levin, Johannes Möller, Laura Fraticelli, Ed Stephenson, and Giorgio Mirto.
