


Graduating Student Survey: Item Frequency Report

Spring 2022









For this degree, what was your status when you entered USA?





How many hours a week do you work for pay (on & off campus)?









After graduation, which of the following will be your primary activity related to employment?





Did your major or field of study prepare you for your current position?












Do you believe that your major or field of study has prepared you for the type of position you will seek?



After graduation, what are your plans in regards to continuing your education within the next year?







What is the highest degree you plan to obtain?











How did you find out about your internship?





Did you receive academic credit for your internship?











If you had it to do over again, would you attend USA?





If you had it to do over again, would you graduate with the same major?





As an alumnus/a, what kinds of activities would you like to participate in (select all that apply)?




