## 2021 Freshman Cohort Non-returning Students: What do we know?

#### **Executive Summary**

The following report provides an analysis of 546 first-time full-time degree-seeking freshmen in the University of South Alabama (USA) 2021 freshman cohort who did not return to USA in Fall 2022. Of these non-returning students, 152 (27.8%) transferred to another institution prior to Fall 2022 and 394 (72.2%) "stopped out" or did not enroll in another college or university.

Results indicated a large majority of transfer students transferred to another public institution located in Alabama. Initial indicators (known prior to Fall 2021) to monitor in order to identify students at greater risk to "stop out" instead of transferring to another institution included local students from Mobile or Baldwin County (32.6%), did not attend an individual or family tour on campus or their tour attendance was unknown (19.8%), received a Pell Grant (17.4%), lived off-campus (16.5%), first generation student (13.5%), and did not attend a Southbound orientation or open house on campus or their attendance was unknown (11.6%).

Results known after the end of Fall 2021 showed a large percentage based differential between students who received four or more at-risk midterm grades in Fall 2021 (20.9%) compared to students who transferred and had a similar number of at-risk midterm grades. End of Summer 2022 findings showed a large percentage based differential between students who "stopped out" with a USA GPA of 2.0 or lower (43.8%) and students with zero to six hours earned at USA (29.5%) compared to students who transferred and had a similar USA GPA or a similar number of USA hours earned.

#### Overview

The following report provides an analysis of 546 first-time full-time degree-seeking freshmen in the University of South Alabama (USA) 2021 freshman cohort who did not return to USA in Fall 2022. The National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) was used to identify whether non-returning students transferred to another institution or "stopped out" and did not enroll in another higher education institution in Fall 2022. While the preference is for students to return and persist at USA, a student who transferred to another institution could be considered a secondary measure of student success.

More than 3,600 colleges and universities in the United States participate in the NSC. With NSC participating institutions enrolling over 97% of all students in public and private colleges and universities in the United States, students who were not identified as transfer students by the NSC were unlikely to be enrolled at another college or university and had "stopped out" of higher education. This report provides comparisons between 152 non-returning students who transferred to another institution prior to Fall 2022 and 394 non-returning students who "stopped out" and did not enroll at another college or university.

#### Profile of Non-returning Student Who "Stopped Out" and Transferred

A non-returning student who "stopped out" and transferred to another institution most likely had the following profile or characteristics (see Table 1). The characteristics are rank ordered high to low based on the profile of students who "stopped out".

#### Where Non-returning Students Transferred

Of the 152 non-returning students who transferred, a large majority transferred to an institution with one of the following characteristics (see Table 2 and Table 3). The transfer institution was likely public (89.5%) and/or located in Alabama (50.7%). Florida (14.5%) and Mississippi (14.5%) were the next most likely state locations of the transfer institution for non-returning students. Non-returning students were also slightly more likely to attend a four-year (54.6%) institution.

The most common four-year transfer institutions of choice (see Table 4) were University of West Florida (9), University of Alabama at Birmingham (8), and Auburn University (7). Of the two-year institutions, Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College (14), Coastal Alabama Community College (11), and Bishop State Community College (10) were the most common transfer destinations.

#### Comparison of Non-returning Transfer Students to Students Who "Stopped Out"

Multiple characteristics of non-returning students were compared to determine what characteristics showed a large percentage based differential between 394 non-returning students who "stopped out" compared to 152 non-returning students who transferred. The following table displays characteristics with a percentage based differential of 10% or greater between students who transferred and students who "stopped out" (see Table 5 or complete data tables found in the Appendix).

Results showed the USA GPA after the end of Summer 2022 and region where the student originated from, number of USA hours earned after the end of Summer 2022, probation status of the student after Fall 2021, and number of at-risk midterm grades in Fall 2021 were the top five characteristics with subgroups that showed the greatest differential between non-returning students who transferred and students who "stopped out". Results showed:

• 75.3% of the non-returning students who "stopped out" had a USA GPA of 2.0 or lower (272) compared to 31.5% of non-returning students who transferred (46), 19.2% of the non-returning students who transferred had a USA GPA of 3.01 to 3.5 (28) compared to 5.3% of the non-returning students who "stopped out" (19), and 17.8% of the non-returning students who transferred had a USA GPA of 3.51 to 4.0 (26) compared to 4.2% of the non-returning students who "stopped out" (15),

- 60.9% of the non-returning students who "stopped out" came from Mobile or Baldwin County (240) compared to 28.3% of non-returning students who transferred (43) and 19.7% of the non-returning students who transferred came from the rest of the United States (30) compared to 4.3% of the non-returning students who "stopped out" (17),
- 40.4% of non-returning students who "stopped out" had zero to six USA hours earned (146) compared to 11.0% of non-returning students who transferred (16), 22.6% of non-returning students who transferred had 24.5 to 30 USA hours earned (33) compared to 7.8% of non-returning students who "stopped out" (28), and 13.7% of non-returning students who transferred had 30.5 or more USA hours earned (20) compared to 2.8% of non-returning students who "stopped out" (10),
- 34.8% of non-returning students who "stopped out" were placed on probation after Fall 2021 (137) compared to 13.8% of non-returning students who transferred (21), and
- 36.0% of non-returning students who "stopped out" had four or more at-risk midterm grades in Fall 2021 (142) compared to 15.1% of non-returning students who transferred (23), 27.0% of non-returning students who transferred had one at-risk midterm grade in Fall 2021 (41) compared to 14.7% of non-returning students who "stopped out" (58), and 31.6% of non-returning students who transferred had no at-risk midterm grades in Fall 2021 (48) compared to 21.1% of non-returning students who "stopped out" (83).

Note: Cells with a yellow fill color indicate % transferred compared to % "stopped out" was positive and greater than or equal to 10% while cells with an orange fill color indicate % transferred compared to % "stopped out" was negative and greater than or equal to 10%.

Eight additional characteristics showed a percentage based differential greater than or equal to 10% between students who transferred and students who "stopped out". The additional characteristics were: 1) number of individual or family tours attended, 2) whether the student received a Pell Grant, 3) housing, 4) first generation status, 5) initial AATS advising appointment during Fall 2021, 6) Southbound Orientation or Open House attendance, 7) virtual orientation session attended, and 8) acceptance date to USA. Results showed:

• 68.5% of non-returning students who "stopped out" did not attend an individual or family tour on campus or their tour attendance was unknown (270) compared to 48.7% of non-

returning students who transferred (74) and 48.0% of non-returning students who transferred attended one individual or family on campus recruitment visit (73) compared to 30.7% of non-returning students who "stopped out" (121),

- 58.9% of the non-returning students who "stopped out" received a Pell Grant (232) compared to 41.4% of non-returning students who transferred (63),
- 45.4% of the non-returning students who "stopped out" lived off-campus (179) compared to 28.9% of non-returning students who transferred (44),
- 70.4% of the non-returning students who transferred were not first generation students (107) compared to 56.6% of non-returning students who "stopped out" (223) and 33.2% of non-returning students who "stopped out" were first generation students (131) compared to 19.7% of non-returning students who transferred (30),
- 35.6% of the non-returning students who transferred attended their first advising appointment with Academic Advising and Transfer Services (AATS) in September (54) compared to 23.4% of the non-returning students who "stopped out" (92),
- 75.4% of the non-returning students who "stopped out" did not attend a Southbound orientation or open house or their attendance was unknown (297) compared to 63.8% of the non-returning students who transferred (97) and 34.9% of the non-returning students who transferred attended a Southbound Orientation (53) compared to 24.1% of the non-returning students who "stopped out" (95),
- 19.7% of the non-returning students who transferred attended the Freshman Session 2 orientation session (30) compared to 8.4% of the non-returning students who "stopped out" (33), and
- 79.6% of the non-returning students who transferred had an acceptance date to USA on or before February 15 (121) compared to 69.5% of the non-returning students who "stopped out" (274).

#### **Implications**

The findings showed initial indicators (known prior to Fall 2021) that could be monitored in order to identify students at greater risk to "stop out" instead of transferring to another institution included local students from Mobile or Baldwin County (32.6%), did not attend an individual or family tour on campus or their tour attendance was unknown (19.8%), received a Pell Grant (17.4%), lived off-campus (16.5%), first generation student (13.5%), and did not attend a Southbound orientation or open house on campus or their attendance was unknown (11.6%). Students with these characteristics were less likely to transfer to another institution and should be targeted early with interventions to help them persist and return to USA.

Results also showed a large percentage based differential between students who "stopped out" who received four or more at-risk midterm grades in Fall 2021 (20.9%), earned a USA GPA of 2.0 or lower at the end of Summer 2022 (43.8%), and completed zero to six USA hours earned at the end of Summer 2022 (29.5%) compared to non-returning students who transferred. These students may have benefited from programs such as intrusive advising and peer mentoring to improve their likelihood of persistence at USA or to prepare them to transfer to another institution. While the preference is to encourage USA freshmen students to continue and persist at USA, a student who successfully transfers to another institution could also be considered a secondary measure of success compared to a complete "stop out" from higher education.
